LOGIC TRAINING “C-PROGRAM ADVANCED LEVEL”

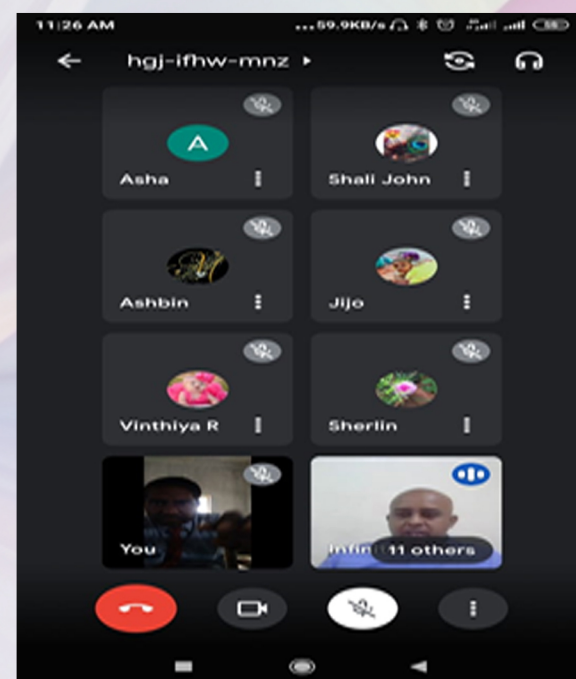
The Placement and Training Department conducted advanced-level Logic Training on C Programming for all second-year students on November 10, 2021, at 10:00 a.m.

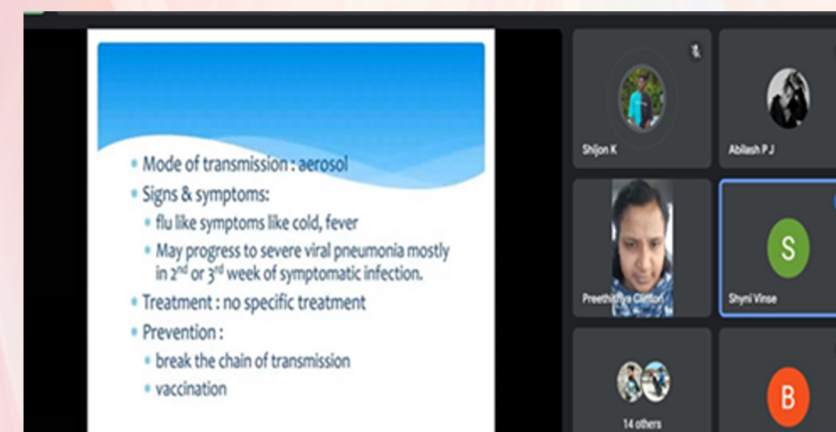


CAREER COUNSELLING ON SWOT ANALYSIS

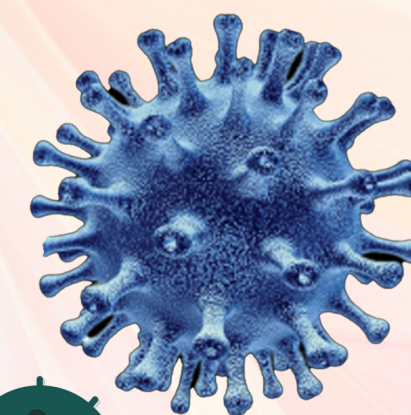
COVID AWARENESS PROGRAM

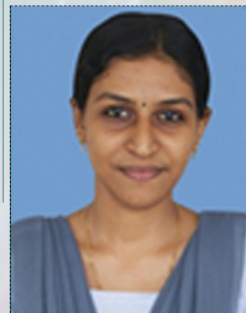

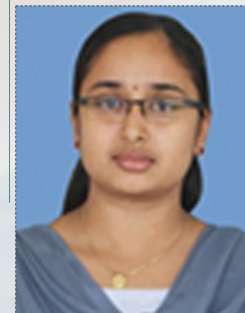
